**1. RULES**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS).
- 1.2. The Organizing Authority for this regatta is the Kitsilano Yacht Club (KYC) in conjunction with the Canadian 5o5 Association.
- 1.3. The prescriptions of the Canadian Yachting Association (CYA) will apply.
- 1.4. The Rules and Specifications of the International 5o5 Class will apply.
- 1.5 Official Sailing Instructions will be issued to competitors upon payment of registration fees. Any sailing instructions included in this Notice of Race may be modified up to and including time of registration.

**2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY**

- 2.1. This regatta will be held in conjunction with events and races associated with the 2009 Kitsilano Invitational Regatta
- 2.2 The 5o5 Canadian Championship portion of the regatta is only open to 5o5s.
- 2.3. Participants must be members of their National 5o5 Association and their national Sailing/Yachting Association (CYA or US Sailing Association )
- 2.3. Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it with the required entry fee to the Kitsilano Yacht Club by July 2<sup>nd</sup> 2009.

- 3.1. The entry fee for the 5o5 Canada Championship Regatta is 80\$CDN, and includes one commemorative t-shirt. Do not send cash in the mail. 4.2 A maximum of thirteen (13) races will be sailed by the 505 fleet over the three days of the Canadian 505 Championship.

4.3 No warning signal will be made after 1500 on Sunday July 12<sup>th</sup>.

## **5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

5.1. Sailing Instructions will be provided to competitors at registration.

## **6. VENUE**

6.1. Racing will take place in English Bay.

## **7. SCORING**

7.1. The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2, will be used except as modified below.

7.2. Three races will constitute a series.

7.3. There will be one throw out when four or more races are completed. When 8 or more races are completed there will be two throw outs. When 12 or more races are completed, there will be three throw outs. There will be a maximum of 13 races.

## **8. PRIZES & TROPHIES**

8.1 Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 crews overall.

8.2 Two perpetual trophies will be awarded: one to the overall winner of the 505 Canadian Championship, and one to the top Canadian team in the regatta.

## **9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **10. INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$1,000,000 for the event.

## **11.FURTHER INFORMATION**

11.1 Competitors and their immediate families are welcome to use the club facilities during the regatta.

11.2. Camping will NOT be permitted on the Club Property.
