## **2 RULES**

- 2.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 2.2 The prescriptions of Sail Canada will apply. The following prescription may require advance preparation.  
*RRS 46 – Person in Charge - Sail Canada prescribes that the designated person in charge, if resident in Canada, shall be a member of a club affiliated with Sail Canada.*
- 2.3 The class rules of each class will apply.
- 2.4 For the M242 and F18 classes only, Rule 44.1 is changed so that a boat may take a One-Turn Penalty instead of a Two-Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while racing.
- 2.5 Sailing Instructions be posted online on the KYC website by 1600 July 5<sup>th</sup> and will be available to registered competitors at check-in.

## **3 ENTRY**

- 3.1 Participation is by invitation of Kitsilano Yacht Club. Classes invited to participate in 2017 are:

- 3.1.1 Boats may enter this regatta by completing registration with Kitsilano Yacht Club (KYC)

in accordance with the regatta registration process. A boat must be registered, all participants (skippers and crew) must provide an emergency shore contact in case of emergency and all fees paid to KYC before becoming an official competitor even.

Registration must be completed no later than 1100 on Saturday, July 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017. All participants must report to the check-in desk at the club by 1100 on Saturday to be eligible for this regatta. The check-in desk will be open on Friday evening and Saturday morning per the schedule described in Section 5 below.

- 3.3 **Cal20 Class:** A boat is eligible for the Canadian Championships providing it is owned by a member of a Cal20 Fleet.
- 3.4 **Cal20 Class:** A class measurement certificate is optional. However, to be eligible for a first, second or third place trophy, a Cal20 must have, or qualify for, a valid Class Measurement Certificate upon the final day of racing if challenged. The cost to challenge and request a measurement of any placing yacht shall be \$100CDN payable to the host Fleet and is refundable upon the non-qualification of the yacht being measured.
- 3.5 KYC reserves the right to refuse entry of any person or boat by refunding money paid at registration.
- 3.6 All those taking part in the racing do so at their own risk and responsibility. The Organizing Authority is not responsible for the seaworthiness of a yacht or for the safety of those whose entry is accepted. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during or after the regatta. Attention of the competitor is drawn to **RRS Part 1, Fundamental Rule 4.**

#### 4 FEES

- 4.1 The Regatta Fees are as follow:

Early Registration, paid in full by midnight June 30 <sup>th</sup> :	\$80
After June 30th	\$100
- 4.2 KYC can accept payment by credit card during online registration. KYC can also accept payment in Canadian cash, US cash at par or Canadian cheque.
- 4.3 The entry fee includes one dinner ticket. Additional dinner tickets may be purchased for \$25 each plus GST. Dinner tickets can be purchased online, either separately or with boat entry registration. Dinner tickets must be ordered before the close of registration on Saturday, July 8<sup>th</sup>.
- 4.4 Official Kits Invitation Regatta T-shirts may be purchased for \$15 each.

#### 5 SCHEDULE – CHECK-IN, RACING & SOCIAL

- 5.1 **Registration/ Check-in:**
  - Friday July 7<sup>th</sup>, 1800-2000
  - Saturday July 8<sup>th</sup>, 0930-1100
- 5.2 **Racing:**
  - 5.2.1 Competitors meeting: July 8<sup>th</sup>, 1100

**5.2.2** The scheduled time of the warning signal for Saturday July 8<sup>th</sup> is 1230

**5.2.3** The scheduled time of the warning signal for Sunday July 9<sup>th</sup> is 1130

5.3 No warning signal will be made later than 1530 on Sunday, July 9<sup>th</sup>.

## **6 Social & Food**

Competitors light breakfast (bagels, fruit, coffee, etc.) will be provided on Saturday and Sunday mornings.

Dinner will be served after racing on Saturday to those who have purchased dinner tickets.

## **7 Scoring.**

7.1 Classes with five or more entries will be scored separately

7.2 One race is needed to constitute a series. When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When from five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

7.3 **Cal20 Class:** 2 races are required to constitute a Canadian Cal20 Class Championship.

## **8 Prizes**

8.1 Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible after the end of racing on Sunday. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each fleet.

8.2 **Cal20 Class:** The Canadian Cal 20 Championship Trophy; First, Second and Third overall keeper plaques.

8.3 **505 Class:** The Western Canadian Championship Trophy.

## **9 Launch/ Haul out**

9.1 The KYC crane is only to be operated by trained KYC Staff.


## **10 Radio Communication**

10.1 A boat shall neither make radio transmissions nor receive radio communications not available to all boats while racing. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **11 Insurance**

11.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000 (USD) per event or the equivalent. Proof of insurance may be required at check in.
